Recommendations & Implementation Plan

FY 2016

The CHNA conducted in 2015 in collaboration with the Ellis County Health Department identified significant health needs within Ellis County and Hays Medical Center community. A town hall meeting was organized to provide an objective consensus building method of reviewing and prioritizing county health issues. During the Town Hall meetings, the group reflected on the size and seriousness of any health concerns cited and discussed current community health strengths. The group identified and ranked top community health concerns, and all Town Hall attendees and community members were encouraged to continue to contribute ideas by going online and taking a feedback survey that addresses any additional thoughts related to the CHNA. All Town Hall priority-setting and scoring processes involved the input of a diverse group with knowledge and/or expertise in public health as well as persons who represent the broad interest of the community served by the Hospital. Key stakeholders in attendance included representatives from: Ellis County Health Department, Ellis County EMS, United Way of Ellis County, First Care Clinic FQHC, Regional Prevention Center, Turning Point Behavioral Health, Early Childhood Connections, USD 489 School District, Ellis County Coalition for Economic Development, North Central Kansas Technical School, Via Christi Village Retirement Center, City of Hays, and Hays Medical Center. The CHNA was coordinated and produced by VVV Research and Development, Inc., from Olathe, Kansas.
